We talked about bearing fruit on Sunday in response to Jesus' words: *"I am the vine. You are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit."* That's our job as followers of Jesus Christ. I found Karoline Lewis' statement to be especially thought-provoking: *"While the branches cannot live without the vine, the vine doesn't have much to give without the branches. The mutual need between Jesus and his disciples is an over-overlooked component of discipleship in the Gospel of John."*

We definitely need Jesus. But Jesus needs us, too! Think about John 3:16 – "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life." How can God love the world without us? Jesus commissions his disciples in John 20:1 – "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." Who will Jesus send if not us? Who will be his voice, the hands, the feet of Jesus in the world if not us?

I challenged us on Sunday morning to be attentive to God's leading to bear fruit. If we ask God to show us what we are to do, then we must not be surprised when opportunities present themselves throughout the week! Here are some immediate needs here at Clair UMC for you to practice bearing fruit:
