On Sunday we talked about Isaiah's calling (Isaiah 6:1-8) and how it connects with how God calls each of us. Isaiah had a powerful and transformative experience of God's amazing Presence which drove him to his knees. His response to the experience was tremendous feelings of unworthiness. But after a cleansing experience involving a hot coal, Isaiah was able to accept the calling from God to take a serious message to God's people. "Then I heard the Lord asking, 'Whom should I send as a messenger to this people? Who will go for us?' I said, 'Here I am. Send me.'"

I was 40 years old when I figured out what God wanted me to be when I grew up. Some are lucky enough to know what that is from childhood – something that impacts them from an early age and does not or will not let them go. Others figure it out in college. Others later in life. And, sadly, some never figure it out at all.

But each of us have a calling, something God needs us to do. Maybe the revelation comes in an amazing encounter with the Divine. But, most likely, it will be a process that nudges you and is always at the back of your mind; something that will not let you go. And, of course, God uses human beings to nudge us, too. Pay attention to others who ask if you have ever considered thus and so. They just might be representatives of the Holy Spirit at work!

During our years together, I have worked to challenge our congregation to grow spiritually, to keep our eyes and ears and hearts open to the Spirit's leading. It's a life-long process, one that requires openness and intentionality on our part. Blessings as our journeys continue!
